

ABSTRAK

HUBUNGAN DUKUNGAN SUAMI DENGAN SIKAP IBU HAMIL DALAM KUNJUNGAN KEHAMILAN K6 DI PUSKESMAS KALIANGET Oleh

Dukungan keluarga khususnya suami sangat diperlukan selama kehamilan. Suami diharapkan selalu memberikan motivasi, membantu, dan mendampingi sehingga ibu hamil akan merasa nyaman dan tenang ketika ada masalah yang dialami selama masa kehamilan sehingga dapat memberikan dukungan terhadap ibu hamil untuk memeriksakan kehamilannya secara rutin (K6). Kenyataannya cakupan K6 di Wilayah Kerja UPT Puskesmas Kalianget hampir setengah yaitu 28,1% dari target 100% sampai Desember 2021. Tujuan penelitian ini adalah mengetahui hubungan dukungan suami dengan kunjungan kehamilan K6 di Puskesmas Kalianget. Desain Penelitian adalah *analitic correlational* dengan pendekatan studi *cross sectional*. Populasi 59 ibu hamil pada bulan Oktober 2022. Teknik sampling menggunakan *simple random sampling* dengan sampel 40 ibu hamil. Metode pengumpulan data berupa kuesioner. Analisa data menggunakan uji *Rank Sparman*. Penelitian ini dilakukan pada November sampai Desember 2022. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa hampir seluruhnya dukungan suami yang cukup yaitu 36 responden (90%) dan hampir seluruhnya sikap ibu hamil bersikap cukup (85%). Dengan signifikasi uji (p) 1,000 yang berarti $p > \alpha$ ($\alpha = 0,05$) yang maknanya tidak ada hubungan antara dukungan suami dengan sikap ibu hamil dalam kunjungan kehamilan K6 di Puskesmas Kalianget tahun 2022. Saran dari peneliti hasil penelitian ini dapat dijadikan sebagai masukan agar bisa meninjau lanjut faktor-faktor yang mempengaruhi rendahnya kunjungan ibu hamil (K6). dapat lebih meningkatkan perhatian kepada masyarakat terutama ibu hamil dalam pemberian pelayanan sesuai standar asuhan kehamilan.

ABSTRACT

RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN HUSBAND SUPPORT WITH PREGNANT WOMEN'S ATTITUDE IN PREGNANCY VISIT K6 AT KALIANGET PUBLIC HEALTH CENTER

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Family support especially for husband is needed during pregnancy. Husbands are expected to always provide motivation, help, and accompany so that pregnant women feels comfortable and calm if problem faced during pregnancy. It impacted in providing support for pregnant women to have their pregnancies checked regularly (K6). In fact, until December 2021 K6 coverage in the Kalianget Public Health is almost half, it is only 28.1% of the target. The purpose of this study was to determine the relationship between husband's support and K6 pregnancy visits at Kalianget Health Center. The research design was an analytic correlation with a cross sectional study approach. The population was 59 pregnant women on October 2022. The sampling technique used simple random sampling with sample 40 pregnant women. Data collection method was a questionnaire. Data analysis used the Rank Sparman test. This research was conducted from November to December 2022. The results showed that almost all of the husband's support was sufficient with 36 respondents (90%) and almost all of the pregnant women's attitudes were sufficient (85%). With a significance test (p) of 1,000 and $p > \alpha$ ($\alpha = 0.05$), it means that there is no relationship between husband's support and pregnant women's attitudes during K6 pregnancy visits at Kalianget Health Center in 2022. Suggestions from researchers that this research can be used as input so they can follow up the factors that influence the low number of visits by pregnant women (K6). So the husband can further increase attention to the community, especially pregnant women in providing services according to pregnancy care standards.
